## **IRF Executive Roles & Responsibilities**

A one-page report comes to Members each month summarising activities of the Executive for the previous month and listing priorities for the coming month. At the end of each year these are compiled and trimmed into ~8 page documents that summarize the monthly activities over the year. These annual summaries provide an overview of IRF activities back to 2003, and are available on request.

## **Annual Business Cycle**

The IRF Executive tries to maintain an appropriate balance between the longer term strategic needs of the sport, and the shorter term demands of compliance for legal, registration and financial purposes. The Annual Business Cycle captures some of the major long term and short term items and places them into a yearly context. An update of the last published Cycle in IRF Newsletter #137 is underway.

## **Annual National Plans – Part D**

Parts of the Strategic Plan for Rogaining need to be updated on a regular basis, and this applies mostly to the Part-D plans for each country. These Part-D plans feed into a less regular strategic review for the whole sport, and they update Council on the activities and priorities for each country. The context of Part-D is clear from the ‘Rogaining 2010 & Beyond’ document which is the most recent Strategic Plan for Rogaining.
